Unlock the Power of IT in 7 Steps

1. Set up your Password

Your username will look like this:

[ab12345@qmul.ac.uk](#)

When you start at Queen Mary, you will receive an email with your temporary password.

Please change this password as soon as possible and don't let other people use it, no matter how good a reason they give you.

2. Set up Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA)

Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) adds an extra layer of security when accessing online services. You may already use this for online banking or your personal email account.

When you create or reset your password, you will be able to choose how to set up your authentication.

We recommend you use the Microsoft Authenticator app as your authentication method.

3. Download the Queen Mary 'QMUL' app

The Queen Mary 'QMUL' app has many handy features in one place including campus maps, attendance recording, library resources and IT service updates.

Download the app on the App Store for Apple or Play Store for Android, by searching 'QMUL'.

4. Access your Queen Mary email account

All students are given a Queen Mary email address. Official communications are sent to your Queen Mary account, so it is important you check it regularly.

🌈 Our email service is provided by Microsoft 365, which you can download onto five devices and gives you access to 1TB of storage (10GB maximum file size).

5. Access MySIS (your student record)

MySIS is where you will find information about your enrolment, registered modules, financial information, personal details and provisional results, amongst other things.

After enrolment, use your Queen Mary account (not your application account) to access MySIS.

It is important that you keep your personal information up to date on your record.

Please note, once enrolled, you should use your student account – e.g. ab12345 – to access MySIS, not your applicant account.



6. Log into QMplus (online learning environment)

QMplus is your online learning environment, where you can access your timetable, module information, assignments and more.

7. Set up Wi-Fi - eduroam

eduroam is Queen Mary's Wi-Fi service.

You can connect to eduroam via the geteduroam app.

Useful to Know

COPE

All PGR students are entitled to one device, funded by QMUL. If required, that can be a COPE (Corporately Owned, Personally Enabled) device.

A COPE device permits users to elevate their admin privileges to install and make as many changes as needed to software and system settings, including the installation of new applications, within a pre-determined time. There is no limit on how many times software can be activated within the same day.

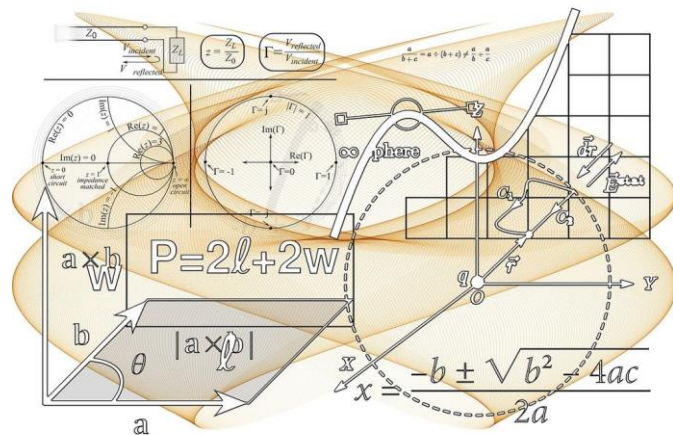
