The Committee **noted** the terms of reference for an additional internal audit on the costing of capital projects, which the Committee had approved previously via email circulation. The audit had been commissioned following challenges with costings on the School of Business and Management and Queens' Building projects. The audit was underway and would be circulated to the Committee when complete.

Higher Education Standard of Recommended Practice [ARC24/48]

The Committee **considered** an update on the Higher Education Standard of Recommended Practice (SORP), which would come into effect for the 2026–27 financial year. Proposed changes to the revenue recognition and treatment of bursaries and scholarships would be challenging, considering the scale of this activity at Queen Mary. The changes would not have an impact on covenants.

Delegation framework [ARC24/50]

The Committee **considered** an update to the Delegation Framework. A section had been added to confirm Council's role in ensuring that the articles of association of subsidiary entities align with the governing documents of the University. Finance and Investment Committee had reviewed the document and proposed that Council's role should extend to the approval of financial and tax structures of subsidiaries. A further iteration of the Delegation Framework in the next academic year would tie together the document more closely with the Scheme of Delegation of Financial Authority.

Scheme of Delegation of Financial Authority [ARC24/51]

The Committee **considered** an update to the Schedule of Delegation of Financial Authority. Changes to the capital expenditure thresholds previously approved by Finance and Investment Committee and Council were now included. The document also provided greater clarity around the requirement for commitments of over £5m per annum which span over five years or more to be approved by Council on the recommendation of Finance and Investment Committee.
