

Data Protection Privacy Notice for Students in Malta

About this notice

When you apply to Queen Mary University of London (QMUL), during enrolment and throughout your time at University and after you graduate, you supply, or we may collect, information about yourself: [personal data](#). This privacy notice supplements the notices that relate to Queen Mary students, in particular that which you will be/have been asked to read when you enrol or re-enrol in MySIS, which you can find here: <https://www.qmul.ac.uk/governance-and-legal-services/media/arcs/policyzone/Privacy-Notice-for-Students-via-MySIS-standard.pdf>. The types of personal data, uses and purposes, retention periods and legal bases for processing your personal data are as set out in that notice. The purpose of this notice is to add information that is relevant to those studying in Malta. It's important that you ensure that your personal data is accurate and kept up-to-date.

Queen Mary University of London Malta Ltd. will be a [joint controller](#) of your personal data, along with [Queen Mary University of London](#) (QMUL) in terms of the [GDPR](#) and [U.K. GDPR](#), as appropriate. It will be necessary for these organisations to share personal data about you and all of the systems used, such as MySIS and MS365, are under the control of QMUL, which also awards your degree, with data held in the U.K. and processing taking place there and in Malta. This transfer of personal data is covered by the European Commission's adequacy decision relating to the U.K.

Sharing your personal data

We are legally obliged to provide certain personal data to state or regulatory authorities in Malta including Identity Malta, the NSO and MFHEA. If you want to know more about exactly what is disclosed and the purposes, please use the contact details below.

Your studies will include placements in local healthcare providers and it will be necessary to share personal data with these and the Ministry of Health, including about your health, to administer and facilitate this and because it is necessary for the purposes of preventive or occupational medicine.

Personal data will be provided to BLSA Malta so that you can be enrolled as a member of the students' union.
