Your username and email address

- Your username is a combination of letters and numbers followed by @qmul.ac.uk, e.g. ab12345@qmul.ac.uk
- Your email address will be initials.surname@ facultyyear.qmul.ac.uk
 e.g. a.sample@se24.qmul.ac.uk
- Your username and email address will be emailed to you prior to enrolment



Password

Self Service Password Reset (SSPR) allows you to manage your password at any time. When you receive your initial password take a couple of minutes to register for SSPR.

The Wi-Fi service is called eduroam

To establish a secure Wi-Fi connection use the eduroam Configuration Assistance Tool (CAT)

- Android users must first install the eduroam CAT app – available from the Play Store
- All users go to https://cat.eduroam.org then click on Click here to download your eduroam[®] installer
- Choose Queen Mary University of London from the institution list
- Click on the installer and follow the on-screen prompts
- When prompted, enter your username plus @qmul.ac.uk e.g. ab12345@qmul.ac.uk

Outlook Web App (OWA) is the simplest way you can access your Queen Mary email and calendar, using a web browser

- Login at mail.qmul.ac.uk
- Enter your username plus @qmul.ac.uk, e.g. ab12345@qmul.ac.uk
- Enter your password

Printing

Print Credit: £10 is added to your account at the start of the first year – you will receive a top-up back to £10 at each new academic year thereafter.

To activate this credit, first swipe your ID card at a printer. Top-up online and check your balance at myprint.qmul.ac.uk/user

Print wirelessly from eprint.stu.qmul.ac.uk or from the student PCs. Once you send your document(s) to print you can pick them up at any student printer on campus within 24 hours.
